ECMS 2019 Travel Tips

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Recommended option: getting from Napoli Airport Capodichino to Caserta by bus+train

In order to get to Caserta train station, that is the reference point to get to the conference venue and residence, a comfortable way is to get to Napoli Centrale-Piazza Garibaldi train station and take a train to Caserta. Please note that Napoli Centrale and Piazza Garibaldi are in the same place, respectively at the ground floor or in the underground level.

Step 1: Alibus to Napoli Centrale-Piazza Garibaldi train station (about 15-20 minutes)

The Alibus is a urban bus that connects Napoli Capodichino airport with Napoli Centrale-Piazza Garibaldi train station (and then to the Port of Napoli). The ticket is specific for this bus, and is the "Unico Alibus" ticket, allowing only one journey on this route in one of the two directions plus every journey or trip on all means of transport operated by one of the companies in the UNICOCAMPANIA consortium within the urban area of Napoli for 90 minutes since the first validation.

This ticket may be bought at authorized retailers or on board, and costs 5 euros.

The schedule is available at http://www.anm.it/index.php?option=com_content&task=view&id=1314 with a bus leaving every 20 minutes until 23:20. Piazza Garibaldi station is the first stop after Napoli Capodichino airport.



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Step 2: Train from Napoli Centrale-Piazza Garibaldi train station to Caserta train station (about 40 minutes)

There are frequent trains to Caserta during the daytime, traveling on two alternative routes "via Aversa" or "via Cancello" that are equivalent for passengers going to Caserta. The number of stations between Napoli and Caserta and the platform depend on the route and the category, so please ask (only) Trenitalia officers at the station or check the big counters above you at the entrance of the tracks section of the station (remember that if the train is leaving from "Napoli Piazza Garibaldi" the platform is underground. The price of a ticket is 2-6 euros, depending on the category of the train, and tickets may be bought from automatic machines, ticket desks or newspaper shops (in this case, you should ask for a kilometric ticket for trains covering the distance that includes Caserta). Timetable is generally available at www.trenitalia.it, but at the moment, for odd reasons related to the fact that the summer timetable will apply statrting on June 9th, the site is not giving results for this route. Anyway, general information about this route on Trenitalia website say that "there are 67 regional trains to Caserta and 66 to Napoli in each working day, 17 regional trains to Caserta and 16 to Napoli in each holiday, with a ticket that costs 3,40 euros" and that during working days "the first train from Napoli to Caserta leaves at 04:13, the last from Caserta to Napoli leaves at 23:19" with a train leaving from Napoli Centrale station to Caserta "via Aversa" every hour at minute 06 and "via Cancello" every hour at minute 13. and from Napoli Piazza Garibaldi station to Caserta every hour at minute 42.
